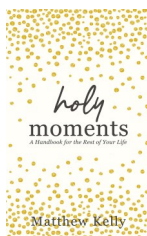

National Eucharistic Congress

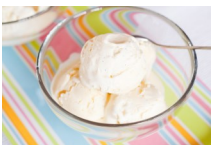
National Eucharist Revival June 2023 - July 2024: As proscribed by the Ten Commandments, the Israelites, and today Jews, keep the Sabbath and it was a holy day, but on Saturday not Sunday. So why do we go to Mass on Sunday? Scripture shows us that not only was early Christian worship indeed on Sunday, but we can trace that all the way back to the very first disciples on Easter Sunday. Throughout the New Testament, we see that "the first day of the week" to the early Church referred to Sunday. Jesus rose "when the Sabbath was over", and calls this the first day of the week. Importantly, the Gospels unanimously cite that "on the first day of the week" Mary Magdalene went to Jesus's tomb but found it empty. So when we go to Mass on Sunday, we celebrate a "little" Easter each week.
