is my body that is for you. Do this in remembrance of me." I Corinthians 11; around 52-55 AD. This demonstrates the five essential elements necessary for consecration: bread and wine are brought to the altar, the celebrant gives thanks over the gifts, the bread is taken and words of consecration are spoken, wine is taken and words of consecration are spoken, and the consecrated Host is broken and distributed among the faithful alongside the Chalice.
