# Sixth Sunday of Easter

It is the sixth Sunday of Easter – this week we will celebrate the Ascension of Jesus. This event happens on the 40<sup>th</sup> day after Easter. In preparation for this celebration we have several readings from Scripture. In the first Letter of St Peter we hear: “Beloved: Sanctify Christ as Lord in your hearts.” As we receive the Eucharist, Christ enters our hearts and transforms them to be like His. In the Gospel Jesus promises to send an Advocate to be with us always, At our Baptism, we receive this Advocate to be with always and everywhere.

**Challenge for the Week:** As you are going about doing activities, trying to make a decision, wrestling with a tough issue, stop and ask the Advocate to be with your Pray simply: “Come Holy Spirit!”
